For those who wish to smoke outdoors, designated areas are available: the Southeast corner of the building and the picnic tables by "C" Dock.

Pets: Dogs must be leashed and under their owner's care. Pets are welcome on the tiki deck but are not permitted indoors or in the pool area. For your convenience, there's a designated dog-walking space at the west end of the parking lot. Kindly help keep the area clean by picking up after your pet.

CAR ARRIVAL

From downtown Clearwater, follow the signs for State Road 60 (SR60) heading toward Clearwater Beach. Upon reaching the beach area, enter the traffic circle and take the second exit onto Coronado Drive. Continue southbound, then turn left onto South Gulfview Boulevard. Shortly after, make another left onto Bayway Boulevard. The club is located at 830 Bayway Boulevard and will be on your left-hand side.

BOAT ARRIVAL

From the Gulf of Mexico: Enter via Clearwater Pass (27.9628° N, 82.8290° W) and pass under Clearwater Pass Bridge (Sand Key Bridge, 74 ft clearance). Turn north at marker #10 into Clearwater Harbor. Continue to markers #2 and #3 at Clearwater Point, then follow the channel to marker #7. Turn west and keep private markers #1 and #3 close on your port side to avoid shallow grass flats. Proceed west into the basin—Yacht Club is ~200 yards on your port side.

▲ Shoal Alert: At low tide, a large shoal has formed between markers #2 and #3. Vessels with deeper drafts should consider continuing east to the Intracoastal Waterway and follow the northern approach below.

From the Intracoastal Waterway:

- **Southbound:** Turn west at ICW marker #12 toward Clearwater Pass. At marker #2, turn north and follow the same route as above.
- **Northbound:** Pass under Clearwater Memorial Causeway Bridge (74 ft clearance), then turn west at marker #1 toward Clearwater Beach Marina. Head west, then turn south between markers #7 and #9 into Clearwater Point Channel. Before reaching marker #7, turn west. Keep private markers #1 and #3 close to port to avoid shallow flats. Yacht Club is ~200 yards ahead on the port side.

Dockmaster Assistance: VHF Channel 16 (working channel 71), available Tuesday–Sunday, 0900–1600.

As you approach the marina, please hail us on VHF Channel 16 for docking instructions and assistance. Enjoy newly constructed, convenient transient dockage with full access to water, electricity, and cable hookups for a seamless stay. Step ashore and refresh in our boater bathrooms, complete with contemporary showers and roomy changing spaces.

She holds a Bachelor of Science in Dietetics from Indiana University of Pennsylvania, a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Jacksonville University, a Master of Science in Nursing Education—also from Indiana University of Pennsylvania—and earned her Ph.D. in Education from Capella University.

Before transitioning into academia, Kelly built a robust career in clinical healthcare, specializing as a trauma and open-heart nurse. Her professional journey has included roles as a faculty member, program director, and associate dean across multiple higher education institutions in both Pennsylvania and Florida.

A lifelong enthusiast of marine life, Kelly fulfilled a personal dream when she moved to Florida in 2017 and began volunteering at Clearwater Marine Aquarium. Her dedication to environmental stewardship and marine conservation is deeply rooted in her belief that education is the catalyst for
