

### INFORMATION

### MARINA DOCKAGE

Available only by advance reservation with the Dockmaster. Space is very limited and it is required to contact Coral Reef Yacht Club at least two weeks in advance.

Visitors arriving by boat must contact our Dock Master prior to approaching the docks. Arrival may be between 8am and 5pm. Upon arrival, visitors are to sign in with the Dockmaster, then check-in at the front desk.

Ice is available from the Dockmaster. Fuel is available via pre-scheduled fuel truck only. Our docks can accommodate a yacht up to 65' in length with 6' draft. Only marine electrical connections are permitted.

# WATER



Coral Reef Yacht Club is located in the waterfront area of Coconut Grove on the western shore of Biscayne Bay. On nautical charts, look for Dinner Key Marina in Coconut Grove, just south of the Rickenbacker Causeway, which spans the Bay to Key Biscayne.

There are two main approaches to the Club. The first is through the Dinner Key Main Channel, which offers a depth of 8 feet. The second, located slightly north of the Main Channel, is the Seaplane Channel, a privately maintained channel with a depth of 5 feet.

If you are approaching CRYC from the south, head north toward downtown Miami until you reach Donovan's Mark at the entrance of the Dinner Key Main Channel. The safe entry point for the Dinner Key entrance to Coconut Grove is located at N25°42.98' W080°12.40'. For vessels drawing more than 5 feet, use this entrance, maintaining a heading of 330°. Once near the docks, bear right and stay close to the moored boats. After rounding the Dinner Key docks, keep to the left side of the basin. You will pass several landmarks: a Shell gas station dock, the entrance to Shake-A-Leg Miami, Monty's docks, and the Biscayne Bay Yacht Club docks, before reaching the CRYC docks.

If approaching from the north, departing from downtown Miami, proceed south under the Rickenbacker Causeway Bridge toward the Quick Flash Mark as you near Coconut Grove. The safe entry point for the Seaplane Channel is at N25°42.13' W080°12.57'. This is the northernmost entry channel to Coconut Grove. Look for a dolphin marker (a four-piling structure with a light) that marks the entrance. Turn right on a heading of 330°, aiming toward the tallest building on the north side of Coconut Grove with Monty's in front of it.

Begin your right turn when approximately 100 yards from the docks. Take care not to cut the corner, as the area is shallow. You will pass the Biscayne Bay Yacht Club docks before reaching the CRYC docks.

The Vizcaya Museum and Gardens is a historic estate in Coconut Grove, Miami, formerly the villa of businessman James Deering. Built in the early 20th century, it features Italian Renaissance-inspired gardens and Mediterranean Revival architecture with Baroque elements. Key figures in its design include architect F. Burrall Hoffman, design director Paul Chalfin, associate architect Iwahiko Tsumanuma, and landscape architect Diego Suarez. Now owned by Miami-Dade County, the estate is open to the public and accessible via the Vizcaya Metrorail Station.

Local Historian

Iris Guzman Kolaya, writer and researcher of South Florida history, will delve into the area's rich maritime heritage, charting the history of boating on Biscayne Bay from the area's first regatta in 1887 through the post–World War II rise of yacht clubs, marinas, and recreational boating culture. She will explore how boating became woven into Miami's identity, reflecting the city's dynamic growth and spirit.
