

GUIDE TO THE CLUBS BY LAND AND WATER

This Edition of the Guide to The Clubs by Land and Water is for the exclusive use of the members of the Florida Yacht Clubs comprising the Florida Council of Yacht Clubs. It is based on the Seventeenth Edition which was originally issued October 2019 and includes updates as provided by the Clubs since that date. Please see the next page for the dates each Club's pages were updated.

Florida Council of Yacht Clubs, Inc. (FCYC) was organized in 1960 by thirteen Florida West Coast Yacht Clubs forming a representative body to encourage the sport of yachting and general club activities, to promote safety in boating, to encourage reciprocity between FCYC Yacht Clubs and to promote beneficial boating legislation. The FCYC founding Clubs are noted on the preceding page and the back cover of this publication.

A principal objective of FCYC is to promote reciprocity among all member Yacht Clubs. Publication of the Guide is intended to assist members visiting FCYC Clubs, either by land or water, by providing directions to each member club, club regulations, club services, and hours of service. To encourage reciprocity, FCYC Clubs provide a boat slip to members of other FCYC Clubs at no cost for the first 24 hours.

The FCYC Executive Committee and Clubs, represented by Club Directors, meet six times a year at various member Clubs. All FCYC club members are invited and encouraged to attend these meetings.

When planning a visit to an FCYC club, please make reservations ahead of time. Arrangements made in advance will enable the host club to make proper preparations for your visit and avoid scheduling conflicts. If your plans change, please also notify the host club accordingly. Club charges, payments, etc. are discussed in this Guide. <u>Please be aware that FCYC Clubs reserve the right to change Club charges at any time.</u>

The information provided in the Guide will be updated on a continuous basis, roughly every two months, as clubs update their page with the Publications Chairman. Each chart shows the approach to the club by water with a dotted line starting at a specific navigational aid wherever possible. The charts in the Guide are directive in nature and are not intended to be used for navigation. Each chart shows the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration, "NOAA", chart number for navigational purposes. Specific navigational and other decisions are the responsibility of and at the discretion of the Guide user. The approach by land to each club is indicated by solid lines and, where possible, directions are included from the nearest interstate highway.

The Cruising Guide will no longer be published in a printed format by the FCYC. It will exist as a digital PDF document which will be provided to each club. It can be printed or saved as a digital file.

The Cruising Guide Committee thanks all our member clubs, their FCYC Directors, Club Fleet Captains, and Managers for their help in supplying the necessary information for this edition of the Guide.

BOAT ARRIVAL

At the flashing red #10 just south of the Ringling Bridge, take a heading of 250° magnetic. Approaching the shore of Bird Key near the bridge, you will see a sign indicating the channel into the Club. Follow the green markers on your port side and the sea wall on your starboard. This channel will take you directly to the fuel dock. The depth of water in our channel is 12 feet, and the basin is 8 feet. The Club monitors channel16 during office hours. Working Channel 68.

CAR ARRIVAL

From 1-75, take the Fruitville Road Exit210. Travel west on Fruitville Road to US 41. Turn south (left) on US 41. Turn west (right) at first light onto John Ringling Causeway (Route 789). Cross the Ringling Bridge. Turn south (left) at the first traffic light, through the Bird Key entrance. Follow that road over a small bridge and turn left into the Club.

RECIPROCITY/IDENTIFICATION

Field Club and Sarasota Yacht Club members by boat only, except on Mondays and when their Clubs are closed for annual shut-down. Full reciprocity to all other Florida Council Yacht Clubs. Visitors must identify themselves by presenting their current membership cards.

DRESS CODE

Lower Deck dining room - Oct-April: 12 - 2 pm long pants with dress shirt, 6 pm jacket required (tie optional); May-Sept: long pants or full-length shorts and dress shirt, 6 pm long pants with dress shirt. No denim is allowed on Lower Deck. Upper Deck dining room - long pants, full length shorts, denim or appropriate tennis attire. Bar and Aft Deck - casual clothes, including denim and appropriate tennis attire; no swim attire in these areas. Sunday Dining - casual clothes, including denim and appropriate tennis attire. Swimming attire permitted only in the swimming area and locker rooms. Dress code applies to everyone over the age of twelve.

All charges will be billed to your Club. 20% on food & bar checks. No other tipping permitted.

Marina Jack (Bayfront) and the Moorings on Longboat Key both have complete docking facilities See chart. The anchorage between Cedar Point and Marina Jack is excellent in all weather. This anchorage is safe, and it is in the heart of downtown Sarasota. A dinghy can be left at Marina Jack if you need supplies.



BOAT ARRIVAL

There is normally a 7 -foot depth in the Governors Cut channel at the Club, 6-feet at low tide. Follow the regular Manatee River channel to flashing red "14", then turn northeast to red "2". Follow Governors Cut channel, favoring starboard (east) for best depth toward the humpback bridge. Stay in the middle of Governors Cut until opposite the Club dock (west side of the cut). Water depth at seawall varies from 4.5 to 7 feet. Contact dock master for assignment. The Club monitors vhf 16. The Dockmasters cell phone is 941-374-2310.

CAR ARRIVAL

From the North: Take 1-275 over the Skyway Bridge to US-41, exit #2, then south on Business 41 to Palmetto. Turn west on 1 Oh St. (Snead Island Road) about 3 miles to humpback bridge. Club is on the left. From the South: Take 1-75 towards Tampa. Merge onto US-301 S via EXIT 224 toward Gamble Mansion I Ellenton I Palmetto. US30 1 S becomes 10th ST W. 10th ST W becomes 13th ST WI Snead Island Road. The Club is approximately 7 miles from 1-75



BOAT ARRIVAL

Intracoastal Waterway to Marker #38, take a heading of 215 degrees one mile to marker #2 at entrance to Roosevelt Channel. Follow well-marked channel to Club off marker #19. Look for green and yellow rudder with Pelican Symbol on piling. Club is located just north of Tween Waters Inn Marina. Monitoring VHF Channel16, working channel 72.

CAR ARRIVAL

From 1-75, at Exit 131 Daniels Parkway/Southwest Florida International Airport west to Summerlin Road. Turn left on Summerlin Road and follow to Sanibel Causeway. On Sanibel Island, turn right on Periwinkle Way and follow the signs to Captiva Island (approximately 15 miles). Captiva Island Yacht Club is on Captiva Drive directly north of Tween Waters Inn.



BOAT ARRIVAL

Using current Chart #11411, as you approach marker #15, Dunedin Pass Channel bears 330 degrees. Follow that channel between markers #2 and #3 to marker #18. Note a large obstruction just east of marker #2. The Club is on your port side. Please note red markers are left to starboard going from ICW to Club. Best water nearest docks to west of red markers #1 0-14. There are 6 slips for boats 35 and under and draft, plus 250 of dock space on the floating dock parallel to the seawall with draft.

CAR ARRIVAL

From north, exit 1-275 at SR 60 and proceed to Clearwater Beach. Turn right onto Mandalay Avenue and go to end. Go through Carlouel gates, bear left on Eldorado Avenue. Club is on right. From south, exit 1 275 at SR686, turn right at U.S. 19 and left at SR60 and proceed as above

CLUB HOURS

Carlouel is open Wednesday through Sunday, 9:30am to 10:00pm. The Club is closed on Monday and Tuesday.



BOAT ARRIVAL

Using chart #11426, proceed in an easterly direction from Boca Grande Pass until abeam ofmarker#5 south of Cape Haze. Turn port in a northerly direction passing marker#1, and then proceed to marker #2, then to marker #3 take heading 026 degrees to the dredge channel opening at markers #1 and #2. Controlling depth is 4 % feet at mean low water. Shoaling on either side of channel. Coordinates are at Marker 1 & 2; N 26 57.567 I W 082 04.837.

1-75 at Harborview Road Exit 167. Head west on Harborview Road, which becomes Edgewater Drive upon crossing U.S. 41 West on Edgewater Drive to Lister St. (.5 miles), turn left on Lister St. to Club.

Geocoordinates 25° 58.71'N, 81° 46.46'W at Capri Pass - At the split channel marker. TURN RIGHT or STARBOARD, leaving Marker G "3" to PORT (LEFT) R "2A" to STARBOARD (RIGHT). As you pass G "9" you'll have to turn somewhat to port to get back to G "11" marker. Follow RED RIGHT RETURN rule and head East up the channel TOWARD the 55-foot fixed bridge. Shortly after passing G15, you will see TWIN POWER TOWERS (65' clearance at CENTER OF THE POWERLINES). <u>There is a shoal to</u> the right of the power line tower, so do not take a short cut. WARNING TO SAILBOATS: Aim toward the CENTER of the BRIDGE when going under the power lines. The 65' clearance is IN THE CENTER OF THE LINES-the lines dip significantly on either side. There is a shoal to the right of the power line tower, so don't take a short cut - pass under the center of the two power lines and then turn STARBOARD, where there is not a water depth problem.

Go under the 55' bridge and turn to PORT. RED-RIGHT-RETURN REVERSES WHEN GOING UNDER THEBRIDGE.







The Oyster Bay Yacht Club marina is located at the confluence of Lanceford Creek and Soap Creek, 2 miles west of downtown Fernandina Beach. From ICW marker R 10 proceed in a westerly direction to Lanceford Creek. Note that the navigation chart shows a shallow bank at the entrance to Lanceford Creek but, there is actually very deep water in the center of that area. Proceed into Lanceford Creek. When you reach the entry channel to the Yacht Club marina you will note that the red marker has been damaged and is temporarily marked with a floating red ball. Enter the marina between the green and red markers and then favor the marina side of the creek, not the marsh side. Take note of the current as you enter the marina so that you can be prepared for a potentially swift current as you dock.

From I-95 North, Take Exit 373 toward SR-A1A/Fernandina Beach onto SR-200 E (Buccaneer Trl). Go for 8.1 mi. Keep left toward Barnwell Road. (0.1 mi). At stop light, turn left onto Barnwell Rd. Enter private gate into Oyster Bay Harbour (please see DINING for additional access information) and continue straight for 0.3 mi. on Oyster Bay Dr. Turn left onto Crane St. Go for 0.1 mi. Turn right onto Bay View Dr. Go 0.8 mi. Take the 1st exit from roundabout. Go for 0.1 mi.
