History

History: The Bradenton Yacht Club was chartered and incorporated on May 11, 1946, with 18 charter members. BYC originally met at the Memorial Pier Building in the City of Bradenton. By 1960, membership had increased to 63, and BYC rented a building on a small basin west of the Desoto Bridge to accommodate that growth. A few years later, BYC decided to look elsewhere for a home of its own. In 1966, a suitable property was located on the north side of the Manatee River. The original structure was completed in January 1968. A BYC milestone was reached in 1971-1972 with membership topping 250. Currently, membership is full at 650 memberships. BYC was one of the "Original 13" of the Florida Council of Yacht Clubs.
