Club History

The club was founded in 1949 following a boat race by 3 gentlemen, noting that with so many boaters and so many like-minded people, a Yacht Club was needed. The club has grown and changed over the years, with the first meeting held at the Upham House Hotel before the club was built in 1955 at the present location. Regattas and race were the focus, and in 1954 the 1st race from Davis Island in Tampa to Anclote Key was established. In 1961 the Club became one of the 13 original founding members of the Florida Council of Yacht Clubs (36 Clubs today). When you join our club, you are also joining 35 other clubs through reciprocity.



Marina
