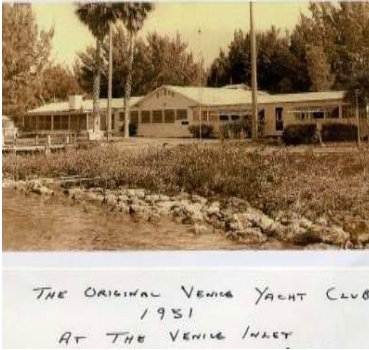

## A little bit of old Florida and VYC history

Our Articles of Incorporation were approved by the State of Florida in February 1951, John Winslow, Commodore. By April we had a home, the Tarpon Center Resort, and by year end the new club had swelled from 43 charter members to 150 members with dues of \$30 per member! Ten years later the new and current clubhouse was commissioned in a gala ceremony. Boats in Roberts Bay rafted three and four deep, the Venice High School band played and a company of Kentucky Military Institute cadets fired gun salutes.

## Location, Location, Location

Yes, we pride ourself on location and consider VYC to be the easiest in the council to navigate to. Our mid-state location puts us within easy reach of the majority of council clubs. Visitors arriving by boat will find us just a quarter mile south of the deep and wide Venice Inlet. Those arriving by car will find us in the heart of downtown Venice just six miles west of I-75. Whatever your mode of transportation you are sure to enjoy your stay.



## Marina Operations

Our seventy-two slip marina can accommodate visiting vessels up to 100 ft on the face dock with 30 and 50 amp service. Both ethanol free gas and diesel fuel is available seven days a week at the most competitive prices in the area. Complimentary ice, bicycles and pump outs along with kayaks and SUPs for rent. VYC dockmaster monitors channel 16 with 68 as the working channel.
